

**Further corrigenda and addenda to Systematic notes on
Asian birds 1-8 in Zoologische Verhandelingen Leiden 331**

- p. 107 Comment 6 is apparently not correct because primary homonyms are permanently invalid (Art. 57.2, International Code of Zoological Nomenclature, 4th Edition; I.C.Z.N., 1999); they can thus have no type. This invalidation can only be prevented, in certain cases, by following the course set out in Art. 23.9.5 of the Code (I.C.Z.N., 1999). Thus *Pitta gigas* Blyth, 1843, can have no type.
- p. 109 Comment 19 is mistaken. Since Gould's name appeared first, Sharpe's name, even though intended to appear first, is a primary homonym. Gould's name has two syntypes as discussed. Sharpe's name has none (*contra* Warren & Harrison, 1971: 575)
