

## NOTE XXII.

## SYNONYMICAL REMARK

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*Diochares Eugenius* m. Abh. Ber. Mus. Dresden, 1896/97, N<sup>o</sup>. 11, p. 5 = (*Monohammus rarus* (Thoms.), Arch. ent. I, 1857, p. 445, t. 17, fig. 7.

Gemminger and Harold have overlooked that Thomson says:

»Cet insecte (*Monohammus rarus*) doit rentrer dans mon IX<sup>e</sup> groupe . . . . auprès *polyspilus*, *fimbriatus* etc.»

Probably they follow Pascoe (Trans. Ent. Soc. London, 3<sup>rd</sup> ser. vol. III, p. 291) who transfers this species to *Dihammus*; but in my opinion it must be placed in the genus *Diochares*, the mesosternum being produced exactly as in *Diochares fimbriatus* Oliv.
