



The lectotypification of *Stemonurus puberulus*

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In the final preparation of Schori & Utteridge (2010), one important correction was unfortunately overlooked.

The lectotypification of *Stemonurus puberulus* (Schori & Utteridge 2010: 194) should read as follows:

Stemonurus puberulus K. Schum. & Lauterb. in K. Schum., Fl. Schutzgeb. (1900) 414, haud *Gomphandra puberula* Ridl. (1915) 142. – Typus: *Lauterbach 2204* (B†; lectotypus, hic designatus WRSL, photo; iso L), Papua New Guinea, Madang Province, Astrolabe Plain near Erima Village.

On the same page, the sentence “The curator at WRSL ... lectotype.” should read: “WRSL has a duplicate of *Lauterbach 2204*, which is here designated as the lectotype. A fragment in L (ex WRSL) has the status of isolectotype.”
