Do NOT use attachments! Half the time I cannot read them, and then I have to write to you, and you again to me, and we surely can use our time better, don't you think?

The format is more or less that of the Index Herbariorum, ed. 8, and should include (where applicable):

1. City (Acronym: official according to the Index Herbariorum, or unofficial, if not included in it).
2. Official title of the institute in the local language (as well as its translation into English where required).

3. Full address, both street and P.O. Box, zip, Internet, etc.
4. Name of correspondent with electronic data (phone, fax, e-mail, Internet).
5. Status (e.g. part of University, Organization, private, etc.).
6. Year of foundation.
7. Main regional interest.
8. Size of the collection(s) (if pertinent: type and number of databased records; Internet address of database).
9. Noteworthy collections from Malesia (and larger SE Asia, Pacific, etc.).
10. Exchange available / wanted.
11. General remarks not covered by the above.
12. Director.
13. Curator or Chief botanist (when not 12).
14. Alphabetical list of tenured staff engaged or willing to deal with Flora Malesiana matters in this order: Mr./Ms. (not titles), call-name (and other initials), family name, year of birth, electronic data (see 4), main speciality.
15. Associated staff members.
16. Associated Garden/Institute(s).
17. Periodical and serial works.
18. Anything else of general interest that I have forgotten to list.

This may look a lot, but just fill in the number and data, and it will be a matter of a few minutes! Get your colleagues to do it as well!
