From the dates reproduced it is seen that part 1 was billed in November 1868; it is assumed that this puts the publication date of the whole volume after that of vol. 1 of 'The Flora of Tropical Africa'.

The well-known quarto edition 1776 has been found to have been issued on March 1, 1776; another edition, also dated 1776, was printed in long folio format, and seems to have existed of 8 copies (elsewhere recorded 25 copies). Actually these were 2nd editions.

A first folio edition was published between Nov. 29 and Dec. 2, 1775, in 6 copies, of which 2 could be retraced. The first in the British Museum (originally presented to King

George III), the second in the Library of the Linnean Society London (originally presented to Linnaeus).

A list of the new genera and species thus described actu-

ally in 1775 is given with their evaluation.

The dating has no nomenclatural consequences, except that Baeobotrys Forst. is now a legal synonym of Maesa Forst.
