Dr Kostermans points our attention to an article by w.H. de Vriese, in Tijds.Nat.Geschied. & Phys. 12, 1845, p.60, in which was noted that Hasskarl's Catalogue of the Botanic Gardens, Buitenzorg, was issued Oct. 1844.

H o o k e r, J.D., c.s., Flora of British India, vol.7.

Dr W.T.Stearn kindly informed us of the dates of issue of the instalments of vol.7, which are important for agrostologists. The date given on the title page is 1897, which appears misleading. The dates are as follows:
